## **Engagement Indicator Information**

Each EI provides valuable information about a distinct aspect of student engagement by summarizing students' responses to a set of related survey questions. To facilitate comparisons over time, as well as between individual institutions or groups of institutions, each EI is expressed on a 60-point scale. Engagement Indicators were computed by scoring responses to each component question from 0 to 60, then taking the average. Thus an EI score of zero would mean that a student chose the lowest response option for an item in that indicator, while a score of 60 would mean that every student chose the highest response to every item.
