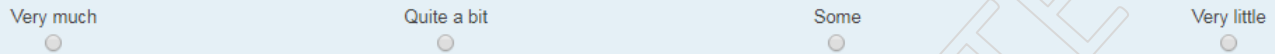

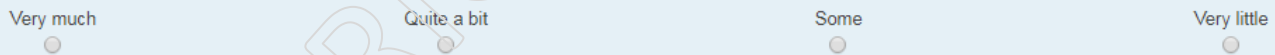

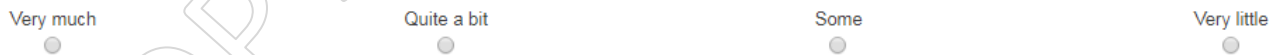

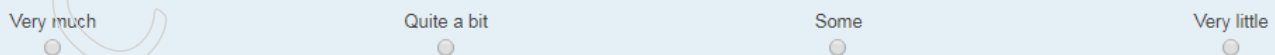

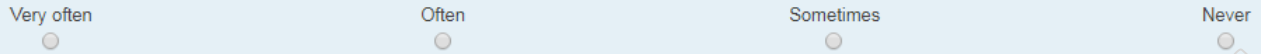

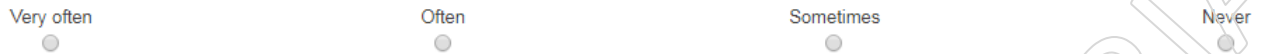
Reached conclusions based on your own analysis of numerical information (numbers, graphs, statistics, etc.)

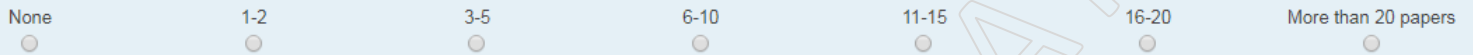

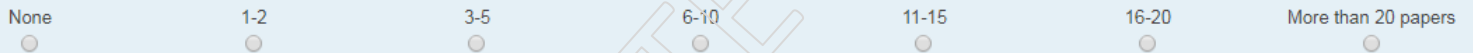

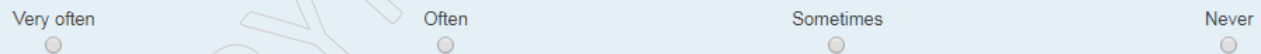

People of a race or ethnicity other than your own



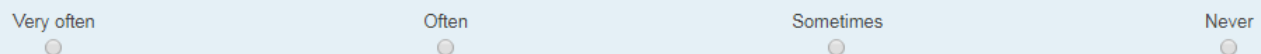

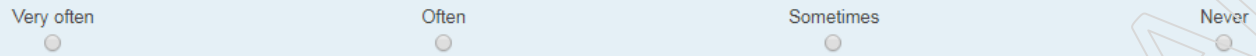

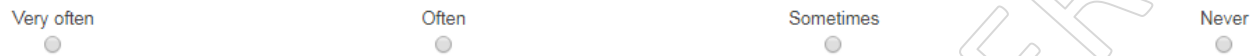

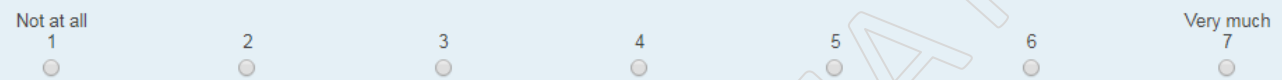

During the current school year, to what extent have your courses challenged you to do your best work?

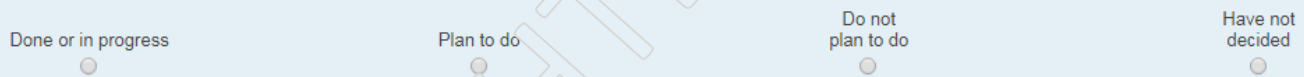

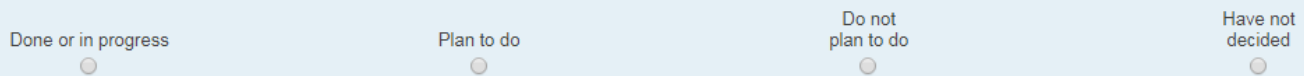

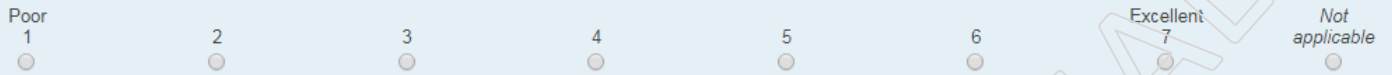

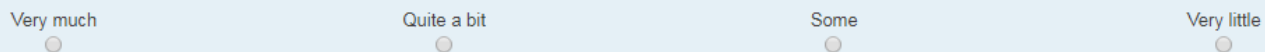

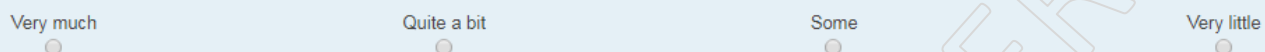

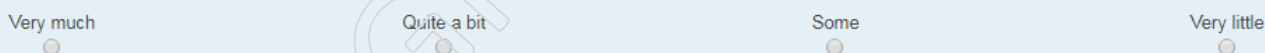

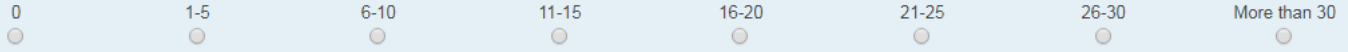

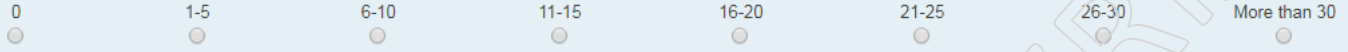

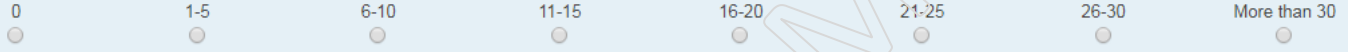

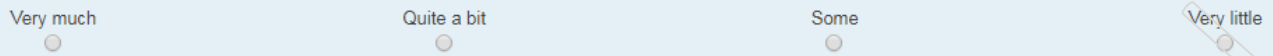
